

## DRINKING WATER NOTICE

### Monitoring requirements were not met for the Carroll Water and Sewer Public Water System

The December 24, 2017 source water sample for *E. coli* counts was not collected in the time frame allowed by OAC Rule 3745-81-65(1)(2).

We are required to collect these samples to determine if additional treatment of our source water is necessary. Although this incident was not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct this situation.

#### What Should I Do?

- *There is nothing you need to do at this time. You do not need to boil your water or take other corrective action.*

#### What is being done?

Upon being notified of this violation, the water supply was directed to revise the sampling schedule to add an *E. coli* count sample in October 2018 to replace the missed December 24, 2017 sample. The water supplier will take steps to ensure that adequate monitoring will be performed in the future.
